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California Competes Tax Credit Program

The California Competes Tax Credit is a new income tax credit for which companies submit applications to the state detailing increased investment in California. The submissions are vetted by a five members panel.



June 19th, a committee meeting was held in Sacramento to approve those who will receive their part of the first \$30 million in tax credit available for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 2014. A total of 31 companies received a share of the \$30 Million, out of almost 400 companies, requesting approximately \$500M in credits. Thus, the "winners" were truly an elite group.

Twenty-five percent of the \$30 million was allocated just for small business alone. The top three credit recipients in the small business category include CE&P Imperial Valley 1, LLC (Biofuel Manufacturing), Ultragenyx Pharmaceutical Inc. (R&D), and Iso Nano International LLC dba NanoCarbon LLC (High-Tech Fiber Design & Manufacturing).

The top winners in the large business industry were Samsung Semiconductor Inc. and Samsung Information Systems America Inc. (R&D), Petco Animal Supplies Inc. (Retail), and Amazon Fulfillment Services, Inc. (Retail Distribution).

Note that the new fiscal year for this credit begins July 1st and the total amount of credit allocated will jump up to \$150 million! We will blog more about the evaluation process next month.
