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
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Greetings!

In the United States, the sales tax landscape is drastically changing due to the recent U.S. Supreme Court ruling in *South Dakota v. Wayfair, Inc.* In a previous

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blog, we talked about how the High Court made a landmark decision in June of 2018 that makes it easier for companies to create nexus in states. It ruled in its monumental decision, that it is constitutional for the State of South Dakota to enact an economic nexus law.
